Antigua Sailing Week started life like all good ideas – an informal chat among chums (there may have been rum involved). Back in 1968, no one could have imagined that that inaugural event would evolve into what is today one of the most eagerly anticipated staples of the sporting calendar.

Absence may indeed make the heart grow fonder because – after a two-year hiatus – confirmed entries for this year's regatta which kicks off on April 30th already tops 65 yachts.

Meanwhile, plans are progressing for the **Valentine's Regatta in Jolly Harbour** starting February 11th, which may be more low-key but lacks none of the competitive edge that has helped cement Antigua's status as a prime sailing destination.

If there's one thing we love as much as sailing, it's cricket. This month saw the **ICC U19 Men's Cricket World Cup** take place in the West Indies for the first time ever, with Antigua and Barbuda one of the four host countries. The chance to watch the stars of tomorrow was the perfect precursor to the arrival of the **Barmy Army in March when the Windies take on England**.

If you thought cricket required a steely-eyed demeanour, try the **Talisker Whisky Atlantic Challenge** for size. There's good reason why this rigorous 3,000-mile jaunt from the Canary Islands to English Harbour is dubbed the world's toughest row. This year, 35 teams from 13 countries took part – each one greeted with a rousing Antiguan welcome at the Nelson's Dockyard finishing line.


